

LINDENWALD BASEBALL INC.

BY-LAWS

Lindenwald Baseball Incorporated, Hamilton, Ohio

SECTION 1:

- 1 - This organization is a Non-Profit Organization.
- 2 - This organization is formed for the purpose of uniting in a central organization, all children, (Boys ages 4 thru 15 and Girls ages 4 thru 18), in the Butler County area.
- 3 - This organization will operate a recreational baseball and softball program for these children.

Officers and Board of Directors

SECTION 2:

- 1 - The Lindenwald Baseball Inc. Board of Directors shall consist of a President, Executive Vice-President, Vice-President Boys Program, Vice-President Girls Program, Secretary, Treasurer and not more than 11 Directors.
- 2 - At no time can members of the board be elected to the office of President, Executive Vice President and Treasurer who are related in any way.
- 3 - The election of any new Director must be past by more than 50 percent of the current board.
- 4 - Any current Officer or Director who misses more than 3 consecutive board meetings, without a valid reason, will be mailed a letter asking for their resignation.
- 5 - Any current Officer or Director who wishes to resign from the board, should mail a letter of resignation to the President and Executive Vice-President of Lindenwald Baseball Inc.
- 6 - Election of officers will be held at the November board meeting each year. Officers will be elected by the current Board of Directors. Officers term will begin on January 1.
- 7 - New Directors will begin their term at the beginning of the next month after their elected to the board.

Committees

SECTION 3:

The President shall appoint the following committees:

- Audit - Finance - Budget
- By-Laws - Elections
- Fund-raiser
- Equipment

The President shall appoint the following positions:

- Senior Advisor
- Concession Stand Manager
- Player Agents
- Chief Umpire
- Field Maintenance Manager

Receipts (C) and Disbursements (D)

SECTION 4:

- 1 - The President, Executive Vice President and Treasurer will maintain their signature at the bank for withdrawals and check writing.
- 2 - All money withdrawn, including checks written, must be signed by two of the three officers named above.
- 3 - All receipts must be turned in the Treasurer, within 48 hours of the receipt.
- 4 - All disbursements must be turned in the Treasurer, within 48 hours of the payment.
- 5 - All disbursements over One Hundred dollars (\$100.00) must be put in the form of a motion and passed by the Board of Directors. All motions must pass by the majority of the board, (51 percent or more).

Dress Code

SECTION 5:

- 1 - Managers and Coaches:
 - a. Hats must be worn at all time during a game.
 - b. No foul or abusive language, talk mean to others or be mean to others.
 - c. You can not use tobacco products during the ball game.
 - d. You must dress appropriately. Inappropriate dress includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - "Big Johnson" shirts
 - "Coed Naked" shirts
 - Apparel with hate slogans or offensive language.
 - Shirts that advertise or mention cigarette, alcohol products and narcotics or suggested drugs.
- 2 - Players:
 - a. Hats must be worn at all time during the game.
 - b. All players must be dress the same.
 1. Lindenwald Baseball Hat.
 2. Lindenwald Baseball Shirt.
 3. Regulation Baseball Pants. No Shorts will be permitted.

League Champions

SECTION 6:

- 1 - There is no league champion in our T-Ball league. Lindenwald Baseball Inc. will continue to buy and distribute trophies to all T-Ball players.
- 2 - All leagues, except T-ball, with four (4) or more teams in that league, the league champion will receive trophies for each player on that team, a trophy for the manager, up to 2 trophies for coaches and a plaque for the team sponsor.

Tournaments

SECTION 7:

- 1 - Lindenwald Baseball Inc. will pay for one (1) tournament for each all star team in the league.
- 2 - It will be the responsibility of those teams to pay for any additional tournaments they wish to enter.

Dissolution of Lindenwald Baseball Inc.

SECTION 8:

- 1 - In the event, Lindenwald Baseball Inc. dissolves, all assets will be sold and deposited in the Lindenwald Baseball Inc. bank account.
- 2 - All outstanding bills will be paid in full.
- 3 - At the conclusion of all transactions of sales and bills due, the remaining account balance of Lindenwald Baseball Inc. is to be donated to the Childrens Hospital of Cincinnati for the research and care of children.
